Job Type: Seasonal, from April – mid October

Required Qualifications:

- Small Vessel Operator Proficiency (SVOP)
- Marine Emergency Duties A3 (MED-A3)
- Basic Marine First Aid
- Radio Operators Certificate Marine (ROC-M)
- Food Safe

Required Skills and knowledge:

- Share information and knowledge of local area, history, and wildlife
- Experience operating similar vessels
- Understanding of guests needs and ability to accommodate
- Safely navigate the tour area
- Ability to work alone
- Ability to communicate clearly and effectively with guests

General Duties Include but are not limited to:

- Operating vessel alone with up to 12 passengers
- Ensuring vessel is stocked with necessary safety equipment before leaving the dock
- Ensuring the comfort and safety of guests
- Operating the vessel in a responsible manner around wildlife
- Serving guests lunch
- General cleaning of Vessel
- Pre-trip prep, including but not limited to ensuring lunches, coffee and water are onboard
- Delivering a predeparture talk with guests, supplying suits and answering any questions
- Ensuring guests have a great experience with Campbell River Whale Watching!
